



## St. Mary the Virgin Church Eccleston

Listed Grade II\* pink sandstone building dating from the 14th century.

Work consisted of repairs and repointing to stonework, together with tower roof.

Due to limited funding, there was a need to prioritise the most urgent work such as timber treatment/replacement. Leadwork was completely renewed. All work was carried out to the highest conservation standards.

In undertaking this project, we sought to respect the historic fabric of the building and recognised the need to minimise intervention whilst stabilising and conserving the existing stonework.

Work was funded by the EH/HLF Repair grant and various other funds.
