



Townhead Slaidburn

Listed Grade II* built in the early 18th century as a hunting lodge enclosing a much earlier structure.

Townhead is a fine, well proportioned Georgian mansion containing an outstanding example of 18th century plasterwork. It is in urgent need of repair, being on the English Heritage "Buildings at Risk" register.

Preparatory investigation work, including a detailed repair survey, specifications and drawings have been prepared by ourselves. A conservation plan has been prepared for English Heritage.

Work up to this point has been funded by English Heritage. A decision on a major grant is pending
