



The White Church Lytham

Listed Grade II* built of white faience blocks in 1907-12 by Briggs, Wolstenholme and Thornely.

Major phased conservation work involved re-pointing, repair and replacement of faience blocks. Roof repairs were also undertaken including re-supporting the reinforced concrete dome, re-slating and re-leading the transepts.

Work was funded by the EH/HLF Repair grant scheme.
